PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Schedule: Monday-Friday 8:00-2:30 | 4.5 weeks

Roadmap to Success:

This 150 hour course focuses on overcoming barriers to employment through cognitive thinking transformation, soft-skills development, professional communication, conflict resolution, time management, job searching, targeted resume building, interviewing techniques, Managing job-related issues, and computer skills.

Goals and Outcomes:

- Become comfortable using and applying basic computer skills
- Create a chronological or functional resume
- Discuss soft skills and hard skills in a power statement
- Learn and apply advanced interview techniques
- Obtain employment and/or advanced vocational training

Eligibility/Application Process

- 1. Students eligible for our program **MUST** have a criminal background, and/or history with chemical dependency
- 2. Referral by a probation officer, corrections officer, case manager, etc.
- 3. Interview with Pioneer Workforce Development
- 4. Pass a Urinalysis onsite at Pioneer
- 5. Consent to a Washington State Patrol Background Check
- 6. Be interested in working toward full-time employment
- 7. Adhere to Pioneer Core Values and classroom policies

AFTER ROADMAP TO SUCCESS

Pioneer on the Job Training Programs: Upon completion of the Roadmap to Success class students will have the option to apply for Pioneer occupational training programs (depending on scheduled availability).

- 1. Warehouse Transportation & Logistics This two week program is located at Pioneer Food Buying Services in Kent, WA. This WTL program is designed to provide training in forklift equipment, shipping & receiving, inventory management, order processing, warehouse cleaning, and safety. Participants will earn relevant certifications in First Aid/CPR, OSHA-10, and Forklift Operation.
- Food Service Training Pioneer's Central Food Services hosts this program, designed to focus on the specific culinary skills needed to work in a food services position. During the 16 week program, our students receive handson training to master the skills needed for planning and preparing food for restaurant, caterer or commercial kitchen. All graduates receive a ServSafe certification upon completion.
- 3. **Manufacturing Academy** provides pre-apprenticeship training to men and women interested in manufacturing. This 10-week course offers the basics in manufacturing and safety to better position candidates for entry-level positions. The academy uses an accredited curriculum sponsored by AJAC, all graduates receive the following certificates: basic manufacturing, LEAN, forklift, flagger, OSHA/MSDS, and First Aid/CPR.
