

## **Mentor Program Requirement and Qualifications Form**

### **Pioneer Mission**

We are a social enterprise that provides individuals with criminal histories the opportunity to lead healthy, productive lives.

### **Pioneer Vision**

Every person we serve has an opportunity to transcend his or her past and be embraced as a valuable member of society.

### **Mentor Role**

- Take the lead in supporting students through ongoing, one-on-one mentoring
- Serve as a source of support and a positive role model by modeling desirable behaviors
- Build a relationship with a mentee by planning and participating in activities together
- Build self-esteem and motivation
- Help with goal setting and goal achievement
- Establish and maintain appropriate boundaries with mentee

### **Time Commitment**

- Mentor should meet with mentee one hour a month or more
- In addition to the in-person monthly meeting, communicate with the mentee routinely by telephone or email to keep abreast of progress or set-backs
- Attend an initial mentor orientation and additional training sessions during each year of participation in the program

### **Mentor Requirements**

- 21 years of age and older
- No felony convictions within the past three years
- Open to working with people of diverse races with criminal backgrounds
- Adhere to program policies and procedures
- Dependable and consistent in meeting time commitments
- Support PHS core values: *Respect, Accountability, Positive Change, Innovation, Relationships, Balance*

### **Desirable Qualities**

- Encouraging, patient and flexible
- Willing and active listener
- Tolerant and respectful of individual differences
- Ability to receive and give constructive feedback to improve the mentoring relationship
- Ability to practice problem solving skills

- Personal fulfillment through contribution to an individual and community
- Satisfaction in helping mentee mature, progress and achieve goals
- On-going education in the needs of those incarcerated
- Participation in a mentor support group
- Support and supervision to help the mentor/mentee match succeed
