

The following are the list of items that you CAN and CAN NOT bring to residential treatment at **Pioneer Center North** and **Pioneer Center East**. Please limit items to two bags.

ITEMS ALLOWED

- Pillows - new, sealed only
- Comforter/Quilt
- Alarm Clock - with no radio
- Hair Dryer/Curling Iron
- Gels/Lotions/Deodorant
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Guitar or Small Musical Instrument
- Art or Craft supplies (NON-TOXIC)
- Leather Crafts (NON-TOXIC) No tools
- NO MORE than 2 bags of clothing, or enough for 1 week
- Walkman Radio or handheld CD Player with earphones (no external speakers)
- MP3 players with no other features
- Books (non-pornographic)
- Family Photos
- Doctor prescribed medications (must be in pharmacy labeled containers)
- Pre-Paid phone cards
- FDA approved Nicotine Replacement
- Fans - no larger than 8"

Valid ID issued by State, Federal, or local government is required for anyone who is interested in participating in the vocational program, must be a "List B" document that has a photograph:

- Passports
- State Issued Driver's License or ID (cannot be temporary, expired or punched)
- Military ID
- Tribal ID
- Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate
- Resident Alien Cards

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED

- CAR
- Caffeinated Products
- Chocolate, gum, candy
- Food – nothing consumable
- Large electrical appliances – computers/laptops
- Television or VCR – no VHS tapes or DVD's
- Clothing with pro-drug/alcohol statements
- Spaghetti strap tops (tank tops), see-through clothing
- Bathing suits
- Drugs or drug paraphernalia
- Aerosol sprays
- Paint
- Fingernail polish or remover
- Fake nails/glue
- Perfume/Aftershave
- Q-Tips
- White-out
- Non-prescription medications or Vitamins
- Tools/Weapons
- Expensive Jewelry
- Cameras
- Bandanas will be put in storage
- Pornography
- Sharpies/highlighters
- Weights
- Locks of any kind
- Bleach
- Beads
- Sleeping bags
- Foam Mattress pads
- Stuffed animals or toys
- I-Pod or MP3 Players with other features
