What are the Qualifications?

Excess Telecom subscribers may qualify for program-based eligibility if they participate in one or more of the following programs:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Section 8 Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Medicaid (not Medicare)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- · Veterans and Survivors Pension Benefit

What kind of tablets and phones are offered?

- If qualified, the client may receive a tablet with 15g.If the client qualifies for a phone, they will receive 15g, and unlimited call and text.
- If they choose to upgrade their data, they can select a data plan with 25g of data for a one-time cost of \$23. (Note: There are no monthly or annual charges for either data plan)
- We offer a variety of brands such as: Sky, Maxwest, Vortex, and Blu Smartphones

What are the costs?

- Tablets \$23 (cash or card) **
- Phones \$12 (cash or card) **
- Replacement Phones \$62.00 (must be paid with card only)

Apply for REDUCED-COST Glasses

New Eyes purchases new prescription eyeglasses for low-income individuals in the U.S. through an e-voucher program. <u>Effective April 1, 2024, there will be a \$10 non-</u> <u>refundable application fee payable online when each eyeglass application is submitted</u>. This payment can be made with any major credit or debit card, pre-paid. The application fee is the same for every individual, irrespective of the type and difficulty of the prescription. *In exceptional circumstances, where the \$10 fee is an undue burden, New Eyes can review on a case-by-case basis. *

New Eyes provides qualifying children with 2 pairs of FREE prescription eyeglasses every 12 months.

Eligibility Guidelines:

- Be in financial need reside in a household with net monthly income below 250% of US Poverty Guidelines.
- Copy of current prescription from a recent eye exam (within the last 24 months).



In 2021, Congress established the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) in the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, appropriating \$14.2 billion. The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) was tasked to develop and implement the ACP as well as ACP outreach and awareness activities.

Effective February 8, 2024, the ACP is no longer accepting new enrollments. As of the date of the enrollment freeze, there are over 23 million households enrolled and receiving the ACP monthly benefit.

What's happening?

Without additional funding from Congress, the allotted \$14.2 billion to fund the ACP is projected to run out in April 2024. (This date is an estimate and may change.) As a result, the FCC has begun taking steps to wind down the ACP, which means:

- ACP applications and enrollments are no longer being processed as of February 8, 2024.
- Households who have applied, been approved, and are receiving the monthly internet discount before February 8, 2024 will continue to receive their ACP benefit until ACP funds run out, as long as the household remains enrolled in the program.
- After the ACP funds run out (projected in April 2024), households participating in the ACP will
 no longer receive the ACP discounts.
