## Apply for REDUCED-COST Glasses

New Eyes purchases new prescription eyeglasses for low-income individuals in the U.S. through an e-voucher program. Effective April 1, 2024, there will be a \$10 non-refundable application fee payable online when each eyeglass application is submitted. This payment can be made with any major credit or debit card, pre-paid. The application fee is the same for every individual, irrespective of the type and difficulty of the prescription. \*In exceptional circumstances, where the \$10 fee is an undue burden, New Eyes can review on a case-by-case basis. \*

New Eyes provides qualifying children with 2 pairs of FREE prescription eyeglasses every 12 months.

### Eligibility Guidelines:

- ☒ Be in financial need - reside in a household with net monthly income below 250% of US Poverty Guidelines.
- ☒ Copy of current prescription from a recent eye exam (within the last 24 months).

### Application Procedure:

- ☒ Bring unexpired eyeglass prescription to **Carnegie Resource Center**.
- ☒ Fill out E-voucher application.
- ☒ Select eyeglass frames.
- ☒ If approved, glasses will be delivered within 5-7 business days.

## FAQs

### What is an LFO?

A Legal Financial Obligations (LFOs) are court imposed fees and fines that may impact one's ability to afford basic needs. This clinic will seek to waive court imposed fines and fees related to felony convictions in Superior Court cases.

## What to Expect

### Do I qualify?

You may be eligible if you are low-to-moderate income or you receive specified government benefits. It doesn't hurt to apply for these free services!

### Will I have to go to court?

You may, but do NOT need to go to court. Just fill out the paperwork **BY September 13, 2024** and we'll do the rest!

### What happens if I cannot pay my LFOs?

**Jail Time:** If the court finds you intentionally failed to pay your LFOs, **you may face up to 60 days in county jail.**

**Loss of Benefits:** Failure to pay your LFOs may result in loss of government benefits such as:

- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF),
- State Family Assistance (SFA),
- Pregnant Women Assistance (PWA),
- Aged, Blind, or Disabled (ABD) cash,
- referral to the Housing and Essential Needs (HEN) program,
- Basic Food Benefits; and
- federally-funded housing.
- You also may lose your veteran benefits.

**Impact on Credit:** Not paying your LFOs will hurt your credit score - making it harder to:

- rent or buy a home;
- apply for loans; or
- purchase a car.
