

1717 & 1723 Belmont Avenue

Pioneer Human Services plans to redevelop existing housing on Belmont Avenue. The new building will expand support services, create new classroom and community space, and continue to provide much-needed affordable housing on Capitol Hill. The new building will include 90 apartments in a seven-story building, replacing a three-story building and parking lot.

Pioneer Human Services began in 1963 with a halfway house founded by a disbarred attorney. Fifty-four years later, PHS continues to support individuals leaving the justice system with low-barrier housing opportunities, job training programs, treatment services, and counseling.
